The lucky few had fathers, mothers, husbands, or distant admirers who encouraged their scientific ambitions. This volume shows that despite the invisibility of women in the historical narrative of

mainstream science it does not mean that science was always exclusively a man's world. Throughout the centuries many women managed to overcome their marginalisation and excel in their chosen field making vital additions to the sum of human knowledge. This book tells the compelling stories of these heroines of European science, some sung but many unsung, and through their narratives it enriches and completes the history of human knowledge by highlighting the role of women.
