Most intelligence agencies are still protecting their sources both to maintain their relevancy and also their safety Interviews of individuals who have direct knowledge of events is often times impossible and even when it is feasible often times poses risks to both the interviewee and their interviewer Moreover the situation is sufficiently fluid and complex that any book will quickly lose its relevancy Instead it s my intention to keep updating this work as the situation in the Middle East develops and as new facts come to life A separate chapter on the ideology of jihadism and Islamic State will be added at a later date
