Introduction

Ethics deals with standards or principles for the systematic evaluation of the rightness or wrongness of human conduct. Conduct here refers to those actions that are freely taken or that are seen to spring from deliberate choices made by free moral agents. What this implies is that ethics presupposes human freedom and moral responsibility. In a similar way, Christianity as a religion also presupposes human freedom and moral responsibility. This is in the sense that if a person acts in a certain way, the praiseworthiness or blameworthiness of such an action is attributable to the person, not to some determinants of behavior that may be remotely related or external to the person. The relationship between Christianity and ethics lies in the fact that Christianity prescribes or commands her devotees to choose some actions instead of others. Such actions which are desirable to Christians form the content of what we call Christian conduct. The consistency of the influence of Christian ideals and values on the moral judgments of her devotees
