Mathematical Topics in Population Genetics Ken-ichi Kojima, 2012-12-06 A basic method of analyzing particulate gene systems is the probabilistic and statistical analyses Mendel himself could not escape from an application of elementary probability analysis although he might have been unaware of this fact Even Galtonian geneticists in the late 1800 s and the early 1900 s pursued problems of heredity by means of mathematics and mathematical statistics They failed to find the principles of heredity but succeeded to establish an interdisciplinary area between mathematics and biology which we call now Biometrics Biometry or Applied Statistics A monumental work in the field of population genetics was published by the late R A Fisher who analyzed the correlation among relatives based on Mendelian gene theory 1918 This theoretical analysis overcame so called blending inheritance theory and the orientation of Galtonian explanations for correlations among relatives for quantitative traits rapidly changed We must not forget the experimental works of Johanson 1909 and Nilsson Ehle 1909 which supported Mendelian gene theory However a large scale experiment for a test of segregation and linkage of Mendelian genes affecting quantitative traits was probably for the first time conducted by K Mather and his associates and Panse in the 1940 s
