What is TDD? TDD is a quality-focused, agile software development methodology in which test cases are built prior to feature design and implementation.



TDD FOUNDATION TECHNIQUE:

Red

In order to verify test correctness, first newly written test cases attempt to exercise the unwritten code to fail

Green

The developer implements the feature in the simplest way with the smallest amount of code possible so that the test then passes

Refactor

Restructure existing code to alter its internal structure without changing its external behavior
