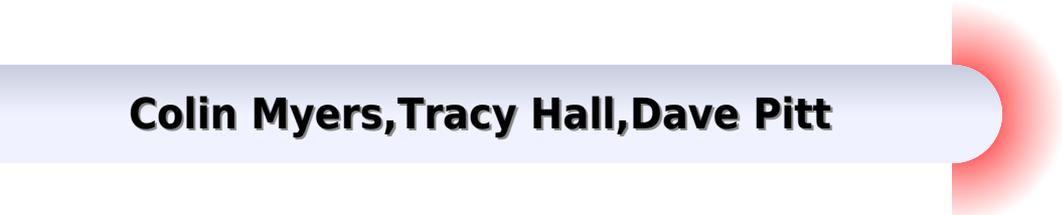


Owner's Representation
