What legal frameworks does transitional Zimbabwe need to support the national development agenda? What architecture of bureaucracy is needed to provide the critically needed policy direction anchored on transformative and sustainable development? How can strategic institutions such as the Zimbabwe Investment Development Agency operate to attract foreign investment capital? What best governance practices should guide state institutions monitoring procurement, corruption, and national peace and reconciliation? How can ICTs and social media platforms be managed to broaden and deepen democracy structural space and practices? The book should engage wide reading among university students, academics and practitioners in the areas of governance, public administration and management, public policy, and development studies.
