The lifestyle described in the book is from a time before the long era of hostile interactions with the Apache. The people designated as Apache in this book are those who spoke the Apache language in the area that is now New Mexico, Arizona, Sonora, and Chihuahua. There were many smaller subgroups that populated these areas; three of them were different groups of the Chiricahua Apache. *An Apache Life Way* is divided into several main parts: Childhood, Maturation, Social Relations of Adults, Folk Beliefs, Medical Practice, and Shamanism; Maintenance of the Household, Marital and Sexual Life, The Round of Life, Political Organization and Status, and Death, Mourning, and the Underworld. Each section is divided into more specific subcategories that explore each phase of life and the rituals associated with it.
