Fichte and Hegel knew each other during their time at the University of Jena, and Hegel was influenced by Fichte's idealist philosophy but he later developed sharp criticisms of Fichte's system. Hegel eventually saw Fichte's philosophy as incomplete and overly subjective, which he argued in works like the *Phenomenology of Spirit*. Fichte influenced Schopenhauer's concept of the irrational Will, Freud's Ego, and Sartre's Existentialism. In recent decades Fichte was revitalized by Nietzsche's praise for his subjective negativity as highlighting the Void of the Real.
