By focusing on the political economic and social struggles of his time it explains Field s jurisprudence in terms of conflicting views of liberty and individualism It firmly establishes Field as a persuasive spokesman for one side of that conflict and as a prototype for the modern activist judge while providing an important new view of capitalist expansion and social change in Gilded Age America
