The Two Superpowers

The US is a democracy which means that the citizens vote in free elections for their government. The US government believed that capitalism, where private owners control their businesses, would be the best way for countries to recover from the Second World War. It can mean that people have different amounts of wealth depending upon their jobs and family circumstances.

The USSR had a different type of government led by the Communist Party. Communists believe that a country's wealth should be shared by everyone. People's lives in the USSR were closely controlled by the government and they did not have free elections in the same way as the US.

The Cold War



The West and East after World War II. The wall in Berlin, the capital of Germany was built to separate the West from the East. It became known as the Berlin Wall. In 1989, the wall was broken down after protests. On 9 November 1989, the leader of the Communist Party resigned and the Soviet Union was dissolved the following day. The Cold War was over.

The Berlin Wall was built in 1961 and was 27 miles (43 km) long. It was made of concrete and brick. It was very tall and had a double top.

The End of the Cold War

By the late 1980s, the Cold War was proving too expensive for both the US and the USSR. There were also protests and demonstrations in many Eastern European countries against the USSR.

In November 1989, the Berlin Wall was broken down after protests.

On 25 December 1991, the leader of the Communist Party resigned and the Soviet Union was dissolved the following day. The Cold War was over.
