The problem of biological time was solved by encoding information in DNA and retrieving the information for each new generation, for it is easier to make a new organism than it is to repair an aging malfunctioning one. Subsequently, small modifications of the standard genetic code were found in certain organisms and in mitochondria. Mitochondrial DNA only encodes about 10-13 proteins, so some modifications of the genetic code are tolerated that probably would be lethal if applied to the thousands of kinds of proteins encoded by genomic DNA.
