As the landscape of 21st Century Rustbelt cities continues to change city leaders are faced with important decisions on how to manage these changes. For some growth is the most viable option. For others especially those with a declining population and diminishing infrastructure growth is out of the question. This paper will attempt to analyze the growth politics of Toledo Ohio utilizing the Urban Growth Machine theory and public private partnerships as the framework. One such partnership the Toledo 22nd Century Committee will be the focus for the analysis. Census data, real estate data provided by a local real estate development agency, newspaper articles and qualitative analysis using MaxQDA will work in tangent with key member interviews to answer the underlying research question: do the public private partnerships in the city of Toledo fit the model of an emerging growth machine? If so what sort of impact might this have on future revitalization efforts?

Governance by Decree Ruth P. Morgan, 2004

The Voting Rights Act of 1965 which originally was intended to prohibit barriers to black registration and voting has been hailed as a triumph for civil rights and as a catalyst for the election of minorities to public office in both the Deep South and the urban North. To advance its objective federal courts instructed many cities to change from at large to single member district electoral systems as a way to ensure that minorities had a reasonable chance to elect representatives of their choice. In the first book to critique the implementation of this landmark legislation in a major American city Ruth Morgan examines its effect on local governance over forty years in Dallas and shows that it had unintended consequences for racial politics, representation and public policy. Breaking from studies that measure the success of the VRA in terms of increased minority representation Morgan assesses the consequences of the Act for Dallas city government and for the wider interests of minorities as well. While endorsing the original intent of the VRA Morgan believes that this intent was subverted by subsequent amendments to the Act and by the courts' attempts to advance the political standing of particular minority groups. She argues that court imposed single member districts have created in Dallas a city council infected with parochialism and careerism, a result of members no longer having to compromise to win citywide votes and have had an adverse impact on governmental effectiveness and voter turnout. With corruption and cronyism now rampant voting rights legislation and litigation have ultimately failed to fulfill the hopes and aspirations of the unempowered and the district system has created an incentive for continued racial separation. *Governance by Decree* offers a pointed assessment of the complexities and contradictions produced by the voting rights law while at the same time calling for the federal judiciary to

exercise restraint in imposing its will when it lacks the capacity to make choices that are inherently political Morgan's powerfully argued case study should inspire much debate and inform forthcoming congressional deliberations over the renewal of the preclearance section of the VRA in 2007

From Gay Street to Turkey Creek, 2007 Using growth machine theory this study examines the newly built lifestyle center of the suburban Turkey Creek development and the redevelopment of the Gay Street corridor in downtown Knoxville TN Growth machine theory is one of sociology's predominant theories used to understand development and growth projects in metropolitan areas and although not specifically defined in current literature I suggest there are many differences in suburban and urban growth machines This study examines the local dependency and organization of pro growth coalitions the tactics ideology and culture used to promote development projects and community reactions Upon completion of this project I found that urban and suburban growth machines differed in local dependency and level of community opposition but utilized similar tactics ideology and culture Furthermore several themes emerged at the conclusion of this project the attempts to structure social life around retail centers suburbanization and the increasing influence of growth language in everyday life the further impact increasing pro growth coalition influence
