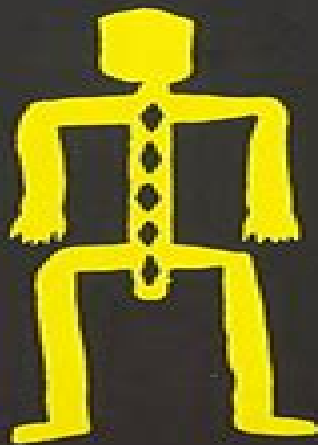

Stickman John Trudell:

Stickman John Trudell, 1994 John Trudell became involved in Native American activism and was a spokesman for American Indian protesters during their 1969 occupation of Alcatraz Island and served as national chairman of the American Indian Movement from 1973 to 1979 He was a prolific poet who combined spoken words and music on more than a dozen albums He also acted in several movies including Thunderheart and Smoke Signals There was a 2005 documentary about him called Trudell In 2012 Trudell and singer Willie Nelson co founded Hempstead Project Heart which advocates for legalizing the growing of hemp for industrial purposes as a more environmentally sound alternative to crops used for clothing biofuel and food He died of cancer on December 8 2015 at the age of 69 *Encyclopedia of the American Indian Movement* Bruce E.
