Only planet known to have life. It has a moderate surface temperature and a very thick atmosphere. It is the only planet in our solar system that has liquid water on its surface.



Mars

Fourth planet from the Sun. It has a reddish-orange surface and a very thin atmosphere. It is the only planet in our solar system that has polar ice caps.



Jupiter

Largest planet in our solar system. It has a gaseous surface and a very thick atmosphere. It is the only planet in our solar system that has a Great Red Spot.



Saturn

Second largest planet in our solar system. It has a gaseous surface and a very thick atmosphere. It is the only planet in our solar system that has a prominent ring system.



Uranus

Seventh planet from the Sun. It has a gaseous surface and a very thick atmosphere. It is the only planet in our solar system that has a blue-green color.



Neptune

Eighth planet from the Sun. It has a gaseous surface and a very thick atmosphere. It is the only planet in our solar system that has a blue color.
