

Introduction to Short Stories

What is the modern short story?

The modern short story developed around the end of the eighteenth century. Before that, there had been short pieces, 'tales', legends, myths, parables and so on, but nothing of quite the sophistication of the short story. As well as the story 'proper' (i.e. with a beginning, climax, and ending), there are also:

- An anecdote
- A 'slice of life' or sketch
- A reported tale

How does it differ from a novel?

What's the aim of a short story?

Generally, short stories seek to show something about life through a specific, symptomatic event, and to communicate a single effect or mood. This is often achieved in part by length. Edgar Allan Poe, the American proponent of the short story, said that a significant effect could only be achieved in one 'sitting' – that is, that the text was short
