The Wounded Knee Massacre had several outcomes. The soldiers who participated in the massacre were commended and awarded for their actions, with 20 of them receiving the nation's highest military award, the Congressional Medal of Honor, for action during the battle. At the same time, Wounded Knee would grow to become a source of inspiration for a generation of Sioux people who came of age in the 1960s and they sought to reestablish negotiations with the United States as a sovereign and independent nation. The American Indian Movement would engage in confrontational and at times violent resistance to perceived U.S. government oppression at Alcatraz, the Bureau of Indian Affairs building in Washington, D.C., and later the town of Wounded Knee, South Dakota, and the Wounded Knee Massacre site.
