- “future” is technically not a tense because there is no the verb is not marked
- The “temporally when”

- The following are considered aspects in English: simple, progressive, perfect, perfect progressive
- Indicates how the speaker views the situation
- Provides information about duration completion and frequency
- The “temporally how”

- For an action that is **in progress:** Is he still complaining about his girlfriend?
- For a **temporary situation:** Schlake is losing!
- For an **incomplete action:** I was just finishing off the cake when my mum came in.
