There was a wooden staircase leading down to the beach. My sister, who was about six and who had just learnt to count properly, went down them and gleefully announced there are 39 steps. Some time later the house was demolished and a section of the stairs, complete with a brass plaque, was sent to Buchan. The mysterious phrase 'Thirty Nine Steps' first mentioned by the character Franklin Scudder becomes the title of the novel, and the solution to its meaning is a thread that runs through the whole story.

Early life and education

Buchan was born in Perth, Scotland, the first child of John Buchan, a Free Church of Scotland minister, and Helen Jane Buchan. He was brought up in Kirkcaldy, Fife, and spent many summer holidays with his maternal grandparents in Broughton in the Scottish Borders. There he developed a love for walking
