OLD TESTAMENT

... Bible, from Genesis to Revelation, clearly reveals that God Himself is the source, supervisor, and sum of all history, and that the center and goal of history is found in Jesus Christ, God's Son (Col. 1:15-20). Thus the Bible, while in one sense a library of sacred Scriptures, is one story, of which the Old Testament is the first part, and the New Testament the second part, through Jewish and Christian revelation.

... the books of the Old Testament have used somewhat different terminology on subject matter: Pentateuch (Genesis—Deuteronomy), Historical Books (Joshua—Esther), Poetical Books (Job—Song of Solomon, Lamentations, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon), and Minor Prophets (Hosea—Malachi). Jewish and Christian scholars alike have traditionally held that the original author of the Pentateuch (except the last five chapters of Deuteronomy) was Moses, who was also the author of the other books of the Old Testament.

This belief is confirmed by Jesus Himself.
