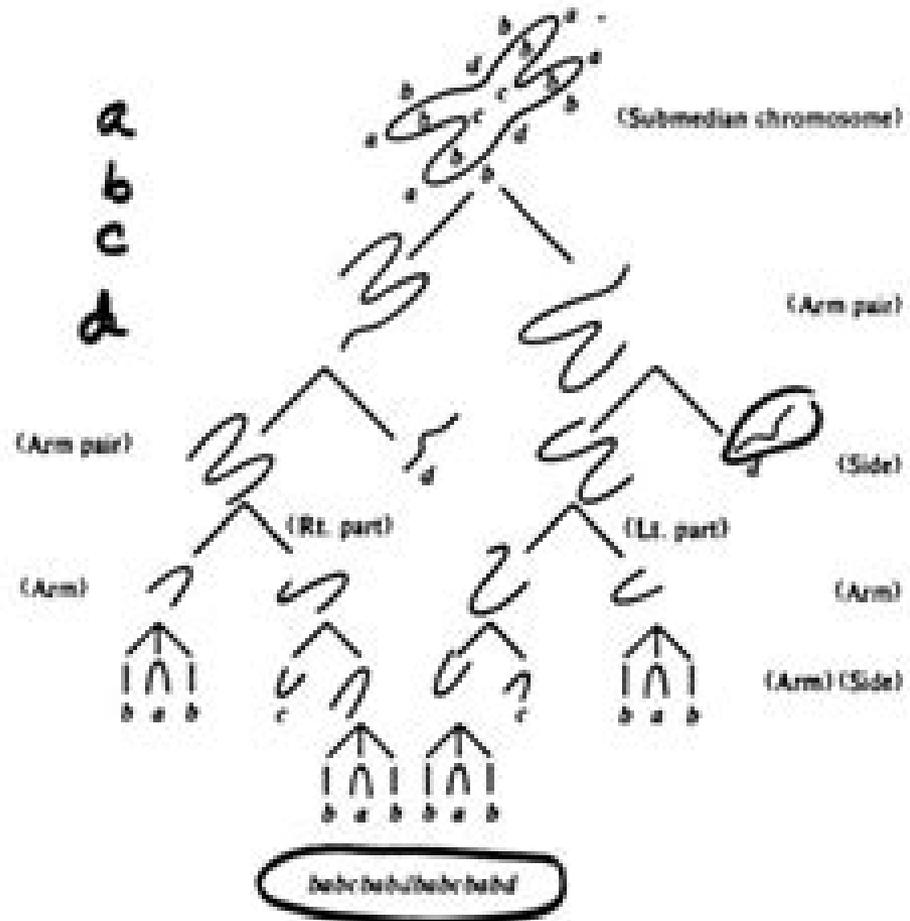

ones would be useful for pattern recognition. In spite of significant improvements in statistical inference techniques, progress was slow. It became clear that feature derivation was a very complex process that could not be automated and that features could be symbolic as well as numerical. Furthermore, the spatial relationship amongst features might be important. It appeared that pattern recognition might resemble language analysis since features could play the role of symbols strung together to form a word. This led to the genesis of syntactic pattern recognition, pioneered in the middle and late 1960s by Russell Kirsch, Robert Ledley, Narasimhan, and Allan Shaw. However, the thorough investigation of the area was left to King Sun Fu and his students, who until his untimely death produced most of the significant papers in this area. One of these papers, syntactic recognition of fingerprints, received the distinction of being selected as the best paper published that year in the IEEE Transaction on Computers. Therefore, syntactic pattern recognition has a long history of active research and has been used in industrial applications.
