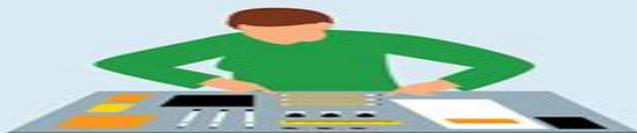
Obsessive symptoms can include:

Bathing or washing your hands over and over.



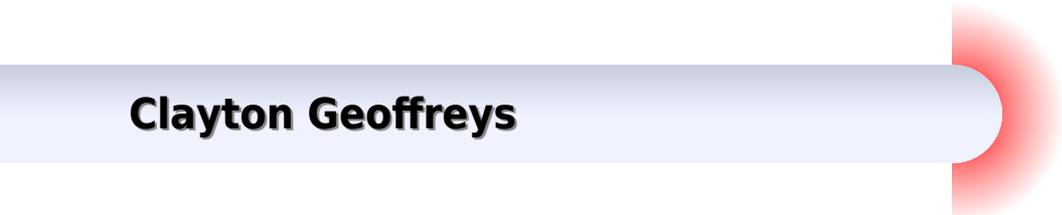
Repeatedly checking things.
