This informal collective of artists and writers, which included Lytton Strachey and Roger Fry, exerted a powerful influence over early twentieth-century British culture. Between 1925 and 1931, Virginia Woolf produced what are now regarded as her finest masterpieces: *Mrs Dalloway* (1925), the poetic and highly experimental novel *The Waves* (1931). She also maintained an astonishing output of literary criticism, short fiction, journalism, and biography, including the playfully subversive *Orlando* (1928) and *A Room of One's Own* (1929), a passionate feminist essay.

**Mrs. Dalloway** Virginia Woolf, 2018-01-30 Virginia Woolf (1882-1941) was an English novelist, essayist, biographer, and feminist. Kensington a respectable English middle class neighborhood While her brothers Thoby and Adrian were sent to Cambridge Virginia was educated by private tutors and copiously read from her father s vast library of literary classics She later resented the degradation of women in a patriarchal society rebuking her own father for automatically sending her brothers to schools and university while she was never offered a formal education Woolf s Victorian upbringing would later influence her decision to participate in the Bloomsbury circle noted for their original ideas and unorthodox relationships As biographer Hermione Lee argues Woolf was a modern But she was also a late Victorian The Victorian family past filled her fiction shaped her political analyses of society and underlay the behaviour of her social group English writer whose novels through their nonlinear approaches to narrative exerted a major influence on the genre While she is best known for her novels especially Mrs Dalloway 1925 and To the Lighthouse 1927 Woolf also wrote pioneering essays on artistic theory literary history women s writing and the politics of power A fine stylist she experimented with several forms of biographical writing composed painterly short fictions and sent to her friends and family a lifetime of brilliant letters
