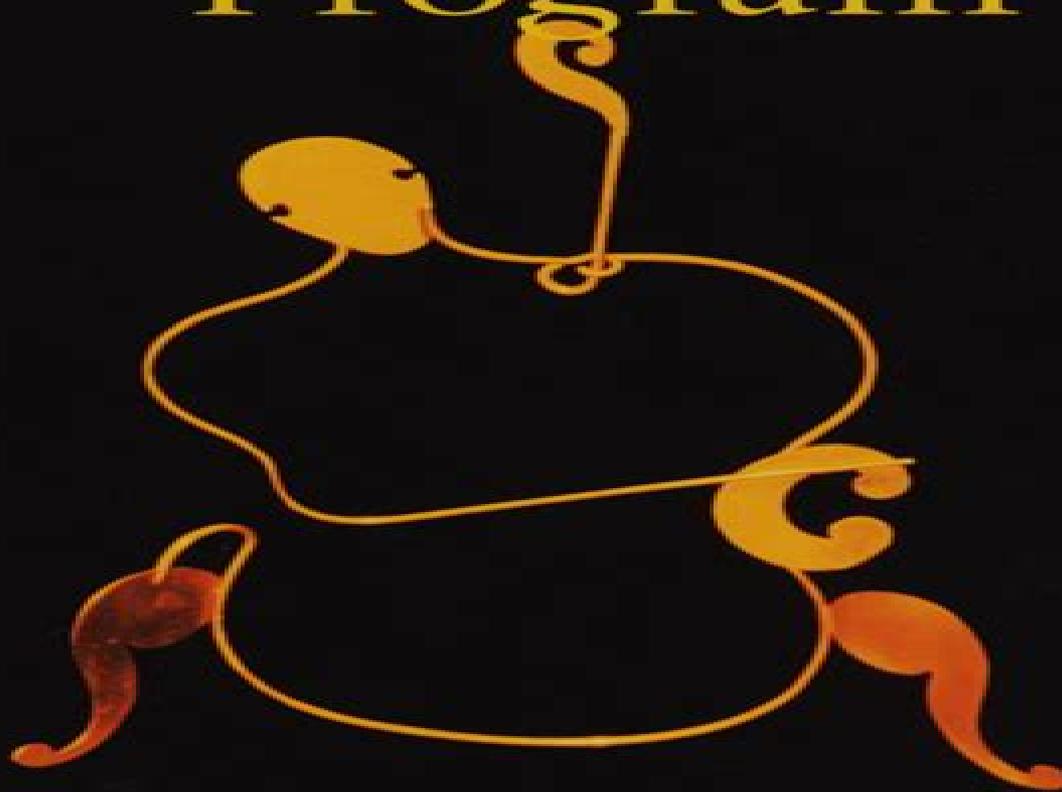

In many respects, therefore, these articles develop alternatives to ideas proposed in chapter 4, *Categories and Transformations*, of Chomsky's most recent book *The Minimalist Program* (1995b). Some of the articles contain references to chapter 4, and some comments on similarities and differences between ideas developed in these papers and in chapter 4 of Chomsky (1995b) can also be found in the Introduction to this volume.
