works which speak most on this subject were published in the 1980s Sherlock Holmes The Published Apocrypha edited by Jack Tracy The Final Adventures of Sherlock Holmes edited by Peter Haining and The Uncollected Sherlock Holmes edited by Richard Lancelyn Green These works discussed several titles and their place in the canon More recently the final volume of Leslie Klinger s Sherlock Holmes Reference Library contained the Apocrypha All of these works have at least slightly different contents
