Complexity often coupled with large information gaps necessitates expert judgement but the values adopted by the experts are themselves capable of being structured and measured according to the value function methodology presented here even if the judgements themselves are qualitative and tentative. Value models for expert panels are also presented. The use of the methodology in practice is illustrated by examples.
