For the purpose of clarity, we will stick to a chronological presentation while discussing works by Van Gogh and by other artists separately. The book contains many pictures by Seurat, Pissarro, Lautrec, Gauguin, and Bernard, some predecessors such as Millet and Breton, and artists that followed in his footsteps.
