variety of learning occurs by applying the situated explanation technique to a variety of instructional interactions involving a variety of types of instructions commands statements conditionals etc By taking seriously the requirements of flexible tutorial instruction Instructo Soar demonstrates a breadth of interaction and learning capabilities that goes beyond previous instructable systems such as learning apprentice systems Instructo Soar s techniques could form the basis for future instructable technologies that come equipped with basic capabilities and can be taught by novice users to perform any number of desired tasks
