

Crosson, 1992-02-01 How do the thalamus basal ganglia and basal forebrain participate in language and memory Are these anatomic entities involved in regulation of cortical activity complex information processing transfer of information between cortical units motivation or in other functions This volume is the first single authored volume devoted to understanding how deep brain structures participate in language and memory Addressing a relatively new area of research the book is unique in two ways First it comprehensively covers both language and memory not only with extensive literature reviews but also with examinations of the anatomy of the structures involved and discussions of theory in light of empirical data Second the book takes a systems approach to the topics In order to produce and understand language or to record and retrieve memories different parts of the brain must operate as integrated systems As subcortical structures are parts of these systems this book endeavors to understand how these phylogenetically older structures contribute to systems responsible for communication and mnemonic functions Designed to facilitate this end each of the book's sections follows a neuroanatomy empirical data theory format Part I concentrates on the participation or nonparticipation of various subcortical structures in language Rather than attempt to arrive at definitive conclusions these chapters explore the possibilities suggested by the currently available data Following a description of the neuroanatomy and a discussion of the data concerning the thalamus and basal ganglia attention is paid to theories regarding the participation of these structures in language Part II addresses the thalamus other diencephalic structures the basal forebrain and the basal ganglia regarding their possible roles in memory The connections between these structures are addressed as is the relationship between current data on the participation of subcortical structures in memory and current neuropsychological assumptions about memory The extensive literature on memory in alcoholic Korsakoff's syndrome and Huntington's disease is culled for insights into what memory processes are subserved by subcortical structures and memory theory is examined in light of what the subcortical literature reveals about memory Paving the way for future research that holds the promise of a greater flexibility and complexity than now exists with purely cortical models this volume will interest clinical and experimental neuropsychologists cognitive psychologists behavioral neurologists speech language pathologists and psychiatrists with an interest in behavioral neurology It also serves as a text for upper level graduate courses covering subcortical functions in cognition neural systems and advanced human neuropsychology *The MIT Encyclopedia of Communication Disorders* Raymond D. Sensory Gating in Schizophrenia Gregory Arden Light, 2001 Anomalies in the perception and processing of sensory stimuli have been consistently observed in patients with schizophrenia Event related potential ERP methods allow investigators to sample physiologic brain activity that underlies the early information processing of sensory stimuli permitting the quantification of stimulus processing In this context P50 ERP suppression has been viewed as an operational measure of sensory gating presumed to be linked to experiences of sensory inundation reflecting a neural substrate of active inhibitory mechanisms Jin et al 1998 however found that schizophrenia patients who reported frequent experiences of perceptual anomalies PA had higher levels of P50 suppression compared to patients who rarely or never experienced PA We hypothesized Light and Braff 2000 that level of insight negative symptoms and neuropsychological performance would account for the dissociation between P50 suppression and PA Thus in the present study 52 patients with schizophrenia 20 paranoid 32 nonparanoid were assessed on the following measures P50 suppression Structured Interview for Assessing Perceptual Anomalies the Scale to Assess Unawareness of Mental Disorder Scale to Assess Positive Symptoms Scale to Assess Negative Symptoms and neuropsychological tests of vocabulary and executive functioning Patients were classified using previously established cutoffs on the basis of the presence of PA at least half the time n 25 vs rarely or never experiencing PA n 27 Subjects were also classified on level of awareness of illness 27 aware vs 25 unaware Patients who reported PA s were relatively more aware of their illness had fewer negative symptoms and performed relatively better on neuropsychological tests of executive functioning Contrary to expectations however PA status did not significantly relate to P50 suppression These results support the hypothesis that self reports of phenomenological experiences of sensory inundation are associated with level of insight and other clinical characteristics but not P50 suppression Seven additional studies of gating in this dissertation describe other findings amphetamine reduces P50 suppression in normals P50 suppression and prepulse inhibition can be concurrently measured one session schizotypal personality disordered subjects have P50 suppression deficits and antipsychotic medications may affect P50 suppression in schizophrenia patients
