Why I Write George Orwell, 2021 The essay Why I Write was originally published in the literary magazine *Gangrel* in the summer of 1946 Four years later on January 21 1950 its author the celebrated novelist and essayist George Orwell died of tuberculosis at University College Hospital in London Under UK copyright law the entire catalog of works published during

Orwell's lifetime fell into the public domain in early 2021. On January 22, artist Louis Porter contacted Pooja Ahuja, a New Delhi-based translator and transcriber, and commissioned her to handwrite Orwell's essay and send the pages to him in London.

Stern's latest contribution to the kind of understanding of the psychotherapeutic and psychoanalytic process offered by field theory.
