

Raymond Chandler never wrote a memoir or autobiography The closest he came to writing either was in and around his novels shorts stories and letters There have been books that describe and evaluate Chandler s life but to find out what he himself felt about his life and work Barry Day editor of *The Letters of No 1 Coward* There is much to dazzle here in just the way we expect the book is meticulous artfully structured splendid Daniel Mendelsohn *The New York Review of Books* has cannily deftly chosen from Chandler s writing as well as the many interviews he gave over the years as he achieved cult status to weave together an illuminating narrative that reveals the man the work the worlds he created Using Chandler s own words as well as Day s text here is the life of the man with no home a man precariously balanced between his classical English education with its immutable values and that of a fast evolving America during the years before the Great War and the changing vernacular of the cultural psyche that resulted Chandler makes clear what it is to be a writer and in particular what it is to be a writer of hardboiled fiction in what was for him another language Along the way he discusses the work of his contemporaries Dashiell Hammett James M Cain Hemingway Fitzgerald Agatha Christie W Somerset Maugham and others I wish said Chandler I had one of those facile plotting brains like Erle Gardner Here is Chandler s Los Angeles There is a touch of the desert about everything in California he said and about the minds of the people who live here a city he adopted and that adopted him in the post World War I period Here is his Hollywood Anyone who doesn t like Hollywood he said is either crazy or sober He recounts his own rocky experiences working in the town with Billy Wilder Howard Hawks Alfred Hitchcock and others We see Chandler s alter ego Philip Marlowe private eye the incorruptible knight with little armor who walks the mean streets in a world not made for knights If I had ever an opportunity of selecting the movie actor who would best represent Marlowe to my mind I think it would have been Cary Grant Here is Chandler on drinking his life in the end was in a race with alcohol and loneliness and here are Chandler s women the Little Sisters the dames in his fiction and in his life on writing *The Long Goodbye* Chandler said I watched my wife die by half inches and I wrote the best book in my agony of that knowledge I was as hollow as the places between the stars After her death Chandler led what he called a posthumous life writing fiction but more often than not his writing life was made up of letters written to women he barely knew Interwoven throughout the text are more than one hundred pictures that reveal the psyche and world of Raymond Chandler I have lived my whole life on the edge of nothing he wrote In his own words and with Barry Day s commentary we see the shape this took and the way it informed the man and his extraordinary work *The World of Raymond Chandler* Miriam Gross,1978 [A Reader's Guide to Raymond Chandler](#) Toby Widdicombe,2001-05-30 The author of such works as *The Big Sleep* 1939 *Farewell My Lovely* 1940 *The Lady in the Lake* 1943 and *The Long Goodbye* 1953 Raymond Chandler was one of the most popular mystery writers of his time His works continue to be read today and have been adapted many times into

The major section of the book, Chandler's World, describes the characters and places in his 7 novels and 25 short stories. Raymond Chandler, 1981. I don't know why the hell I write so many letters. Raymond Chandler once mused to a correspondent: I guess my mind is just too active for its own good. In the seven novels from *The Big Sleep* (1939) to *Playback* (1958) and in a handful of short stories, Raymond Chandler recorded a vision of Southern California life sparked by acerbic observations on every level of coast society, from drug dealers and crooked cops to heiresses. But Chandler's gifts of observation and analysis extended well past the streets, alleyways, roadhouses, and stately homes that made up the world of his detective hero, Phillip Marlowe. Brought together in this volume are some of the hundreds of letters Chandler wrote; many of them composed during long, insomniac nights. Chandler commented on all that he saw around him, from his own personal foibles to the works of his contemporaries, Ernest Hemingway and Edmund Wilson, to education, English society, and world events. Acute, sometimes impassioned, often witty, the *Selected Letters of Raymond Chandler* contains lively anecdotes of Hollywood, critical dissections of his fellow writers of detective fiction, lengthy discussions of the art of writing, and of his own fiction, and above all, amused, sometimes outraged glimpses of the Southern California society that was his inspiration. Chandler once wrote that in letters, I sometimes seem to have been more penetrating than in any other kind of writing. But his letters could also be combative, as when he wrote to an editor at the Atlantic that when I split an infinitive, God damn it, I intend that it should stay split, or dismissive, as when he said of James M. Cain that everything he writes smells like a billy goat. He could also be painfully revealing, as when he wrote of his despair over the death of his wife: It was my great and now useless regret. Chandler confessed that I never wrote anything really worthy of her attention, no book that I could dedicate to her. Lively, entertaining, and sometimes touching, these letters fully present for the first time the complex sensibilities of a man who was one of America's greatest writers of detective novels and one of its most astute observers.

War Noir Sarah Trott, 2016-11-03. The conflation of the hard-boiled style and war experience has influenced many contemporary crime writers, particularly in the traumatic aftermath of the Vietnam War. Yet earlier writers in the genre, such as Raymond Chandler, remain overlooked when it comes to examining how their war experience affected their writing. The sum of this work offers a new understanding of how Chandler uses his war trauma, how that experience established the traditional archetype of detective fiction, and how this reading of his fiction enables Chandler to transcend generic limitations and be recognized as a key twentieth-century literary figure.
