


Skeletal muscle structure



- Composed of muscle cells (fibers), connective tissue, blood vessels, nerves
- Fibers are long, cylindrical, and multinucleated
- Tend to be smaller diameter in small muscles and larger in large muscles. 1 mm- 4 cm in length
