Doha Development Round: Why Did it Fail? Anna E. Richter, 2014-09. The Doha Development Agenda may go down in history as the slowest development round of all times. Starting in 2001 negotiations have been going on for 13 years and collapsed on several occasions in the meantime. With regards to its goal to ensure developing countries and especially the least developed among them a share in the growth of world trade barely any progress was made. To the extent that one may question how legitimate it is to call the Doha Round a Development Round at all. Especially the notorious point of trade liberalization in agriculture has delayed the negotiations. While the WTO member states agreed on cutting tariffs and reducing agricultural subsidies opinions differ sharply on exemptions for certain products from these broad rules. In another critical point services negotiations have hardly progressed. The WTO negotiators have missed every deadline agreed upon and various observers suggested to drop the entire venture. The World Trade Organization (WTO) was established in 1995 and is the principal international organization governing world trade. It has 150 member countries representing over 95% of world trade. On November 9-14, 2001, trade ministers from WTO countries met in Doha, Qatar, for its 4th Ministerial Conference. At that meeting, members agreed to a work program for a new round of multilateral trade negotiations. The work program folds on going negotiations on agriculture and services into a broader agenda that includes industrial tariffs, topics of interest to developing countries, changes in WTO rules, and other provisions numbering 19 in all. Because of the influence that developing countries had in setting the work program, the round has become known as the Doha Development Agenda (DDA). Negotiations were to

conclude by January 1 2005 but this deadline was breached and no new deadline officially has been established Agriculture has been the linchpin in the DDA U S goals were substantial reduction of trade distorting domestic support elimination of export subsidies and improved market access Industrial trade barriers and services are other market access topics in the negotiations Three issues are among the most important to developing countries in addition to concessions on agriculture 1 compulsory licensing of medicines and patent protection 2 a review of provisions giving special and differential treatment to developing countries and 3 problems that developing countries are having in implementing current trade obligations The 5th Ministerial Conference was held September 10 14 2003 in Cancun Mexico but broke up without agreement On July 31 2004 WTO members approved a Framework Agreement to guide remaining negotiations The July 31 framework included important terms on agriculture and began new negotiations on trade facilitation The 6th Ministerial was held in Hong Kong from December 13 18 2005

participating economies persevered. Consequently the fabric of multilateral trade regime is stronger its foundation deeper and its framework wider now than it was a generation ago. Unlike the GATT era membership of the present trade regime is close to universal. The author concludes that of the two phases the latter has turned out to be the more arduous intricate and complex phase of evolution. Students and scholars of economics international trade international political economy and international relations will find this study of great interest. The definitions and explanations of terminology and advanced concepts make the book accessible to those without an extensive economic background.

Agricultural trade: What Matters in the Doha Round? David Laborde, Will Martin, 2013-03-14. In this paper we provide an overview of the agricultural trade negotiations within the current World Trade Organization (WTO) negotiations and we show that including agriculture in the Doha Development Agenda talks is important both economically and politically although the political resistance to reform is particularly strong in this sector. While agriculture accounts for less than 10 percent of merchandise trade high and variable agricultural distortions appear to cause the majority of the cost of distortions to global merchandise trade. Within agriculture most of the costs appear to arise from trade barriers levied on imports since these barriers tend to be high variable across time and over products and levied by a wide range of countries. The negotiations face a need for balance between discipline in reducing tariffs hence creating the market access gains that are central to the negotiations and flexibility in managing political pressures. While the approach of providing flexibility on a certain percentage of tariff lines is seriously flawed the proposed modalities still appear to provide worthwhile market access. Better ways appear to be needed to deal with developing countries concerns about food price volatility while reducing the collective action problems resulting from price insulation.

Implementing a WTO Agreement on Trade Facilitation J. M. Finger, John Sullivan Wilson, 2006. Contrary to the prevailing view that the Doha negotiations have achieved little the authors find that on trade facilitation much progress has been made. This is particularly true in regard to action by development banks and bilateral development agencies to meet client demand for assistance in reform. Active private sector participation has been an important factor driving change. Many agencies have been involved in this work. The authors find that their roles have been consistent with their comparative advantages. As to how the international community can best support continued progress the authors conclude in favor of a cautious approach to the imposition of new WTO obligations in the area of trade facilitation. On the whole this is the approach the WTO has taken for example by limiting its negotiations on trade facilitation to several specific provisions of the GATT. The WTO can continue to function as a catalyst for reform. It is perhaps uniquely placed to relate the trade facilitation agenda to the overall trade agenda. On design and construction of the relevant infrastructures and capacities to spur development the development institutions including bilateral agencies should continue to lead. The authors find little evidence to support the need for a comprehensive new platform or mechanism to channel trade related aid as part of implementation of any new agreement at the WTO on trade facilitation. They recommend however that an innovative

approach to using the well established but under utilized Trade Policy Review Mechanism be considered to increase transparency on where new aid is going over time and to expand understanding of where and how country based progress has been achieved World Bank web site
