many years However several shortcomings of these methods include strong dependence on initial seed values and inaccurate results when the data seriously depart from hypersphericity We propose new cluster analysis methods based on genetic algorithms that overcomes the strong dependence on initial seed values In addition we propose a generalization of the Genetic K means algorithm which can accurately identify clusters with complex hyperellipsoidal covariance structures We then use this new algorithm in a genetic algorithm based Expectation Maximization process that can accurately calculate parameters describing complex clusters in a mixture model routine Using the accuracy of this GEM algorithm we assign information scores to cluster calculations in order to best identify the number of mixture components in a multivariate data set We will showcase how these algorithms can be used to process multivariate data from astronomical observations
