associations with the individual and as a crucial site not only for women's action upon the world but also for her creative endeavors. The essays in the volume revisit familiar texts: Naylor's *The Women of Brewster Place*, Cisneros's *The House on Mango Street*, Kingston's *The Woman Warrior*, Welty's *The Golden Apples*, Munro's *The Lives of Girls and Women*, among others, but offer new perspectives on the way form interacts with issues of women's communities and women creating community in these works.
