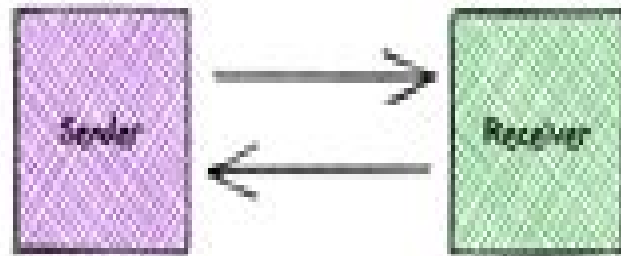

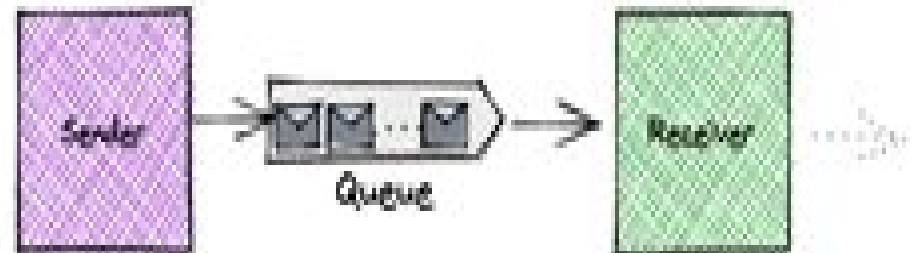
Synchronous
