sit with my children in a home of my own I still long for a hearthstone of my own however humble I wish it for my children's sake far more than for my own But God so orders circumstances as to keep me with my friend Mrs Bruce Love duty gratitude also bind me to her side It is a privilege to serve her who pities my oppressed people and who has bestowed the inestimable boon of freedom on me and my children It has been painful to me in many ways to recall the dreary years I passed in bondage I would gladly forget them if I could Yet the retrospection is not altogether without solace for with those gloomy recollections come tender memories of my good old grandmother like light fleecy clouds floating over a dark and troubled sea
