**The Strategic Bombing of Germany, 1940-1945** Alan Levine,1992-07-22 This book is the only full scale account of the strategic air offensive against Germany published in the last twenty years and is the only one that treats the British and the Americans with parity Much of what Levine writes about British operations will be unfamiliar to American readers He has stressed the importance of winning air superiority and the role of escort fighters in strategic bombing and has given more attention to the German side than most writers on air warfare have Levine gets past a simple account of what we did to them and describes the target systems and German countermeasures in detail providing exact yet dramatic accounts of the great bomber operations the Ruhr dams Ploesti and Regensburg and Schweinfurt The book is broad guaged touching many matters from the development of bombing doctrine before the war to the technical development of the Luftwaffe and the RAF jets and V weapons to the role of the heavy bombers in supporting land and sea operations Levine stresses the impact of bombing on the war and generally endorses the strategic air campaign as worthwhile and effective But he concludes that many mistakes were made by the Allies both the British and the Americans in tactics the development of equipment and in the selection of targets Levine sees strategic bombing as a powerful tool that was often misused particularly when the doctrine of area bombing flourished Scholars students and buffs interested in World War II and or the history of aviation will find this study of great interest

Westermann,2001 Air raid sirens wail searchlight beams flash across the sky and the night is aflame with tracer fire and aerial explosions as Allied bombers and German anti aircraft units duel in the thundering darkness Such cinematic scenes played out with increasing frequency as World War II ground to a close were more than mere stock material for movie melodramas As Edward Westermann reveals they point to a key but largely unappreciated aspect of the German war effort that has yet to get its full due Long the neglected stepchild in studies of World War II air campaigns German flak or anti aircraft units have been frequently dismissed by American British and German historians and by veterans of the European air war as ineffective weapons that wasted valuable materiel and personnel resources desperately needed elsewhere by the Third Reich Westermann emphatically disagrees with that view and makes a convincing case for the significant contributions made by the entire range of German anti aircraft defenses During the Allied air campaigns against the Third Reich well over a million tons of bombs were dropped upon the German homeland killing nearly 300 000 civilians wounding another 780 000 and destroying more than 3 500 000 industrial and residential structures Not surprisingly that aerial Armageddon has inspired countless studies of both the victorious Allied bombing offensive and the ultimately doomed Luftwaffe defense of its own skies By contrast flak units have virtually been ignored despite the fact that

Crane, 2000 The Korean War was the first armed engagement for the newly formed U S Air Force but far from the type of conflict it expected or wanted to fight As the first air war of the nuclear age it posed a major challenge to the service to define and successfully carry out its mission by stretching the constraints of limited war while avoiding the excesses of total war Conrad Crane analyzes both the successes and failures of the air force in Korea offering a balanced treatment of how the air war in Korea actually unfolded He examines the Air Force's contention that it could play a decisive role in a non nuclear regional war but shows that the fledgling service was held to unrealistically high expectations based on airpower's performance in World War II despite being constrained by the limited nature of the Korean conflict Crane exposes the tensions and rivalries between services showing that emphasis on strategic bombing came at the expense of air support for ground troops and he tells how interactions between army and air force generals shaped the air force's mission and strategy He also addresses misunderstandings about plans to use nuclear biological and chemical weapons in the war and includes new information from pilot correspondence about the informal policy of hot pursuit over the Yalu that existed at the end of the war The book considers not only the actual air effort in Korea but also its ramifications The air force doubled in size during the war and used that growth to secure its position in the defense establishment but it wagered its future on its ability to deliver nuclear weapons in a high intensity conflict a position that left it unprepared to fight the next limited war in Vietnam As America observes the fiftieth anniversary of its initial engagement in Korea Crane's book is an important reminder of the lessons learned there And as airpower continues to be a cornerstone of American defense this examination of its uses in Korea provides new insights about the air force's capabilities and limitations
