

Biography James Fenimore Cooper, September 15, 1789–September 15, 1851, was a prolific and popular American writer of the early 19th century. He lived most of his life in Cooperstown, New York, which was founded by his father, William, on property that he owned. Cooper was a lifelong member of the Episcopal Church and in his later years contributed generously to it.

- 1 He attended Yale University for three years, where he was a member of the Linonian Society but was expelled for misbehavior.
- 2 Before embarking on his career as a writer, he served in the U.S. Navy as a Midshipman, which greatly influenced many of his novels and other writings.

The novel that launched his career was *The Spy*, a tale about counterespionage set during the Revolutionary War and published in 1821.
