The Pattees started out in the 1700s as a prosperous family with a house in North Salem village and a 248-acre farm. By the 1820s, the third generation was reduced to owning 15 acres of the original farm and living in a small house built on top of the ruins of the site. Despite his many financial misfortunes, Jonathan Pattee, third generation, managed to hold on to and protect the site.
