




concentrated along the Mississippi The rivers of the Mississippi basin provided an economic outlet for corn and hogs raised in Iowa and Ohio as well as the sugar and cotton grown on the great plantations of Louisiana and Mississippi By 1860 railroads were beginning to penetrate the region but access to these western rivers remained vital to the economy of both the Midwest and the Deep South
