From the table 1.2 classification interpretation validity coefficient, obtained 20 items in the instrument variable X (method dulohupa) the validity coefficient. From the results of the analysis of 20 instrument items of variable X, 14 valid instrument items and 6 invalid instrument items were obtained. This is because the instrument item is said to be valid if  $r_{count} > r_{table}$ , and invalid if  $r_{count} < r_{table}$ .

Validasi bag test results and Y variable (community empowerment)

The category of instrument validity refers to the classification of validity presented by Riyani et al[14] quoted in the UPI Journal on page 6 as well as in the second place classification of the interpretation of the validity coefficient, 10 assessment items were obtained in the variable Y instrument (community empowerment) the coefficient of validity. From the results of the analysis,

obtained 10 items of assessment of community empowerment it is valid, in other words all items are valid. The validity of the validity of the 10 assessment items is declared valid.
