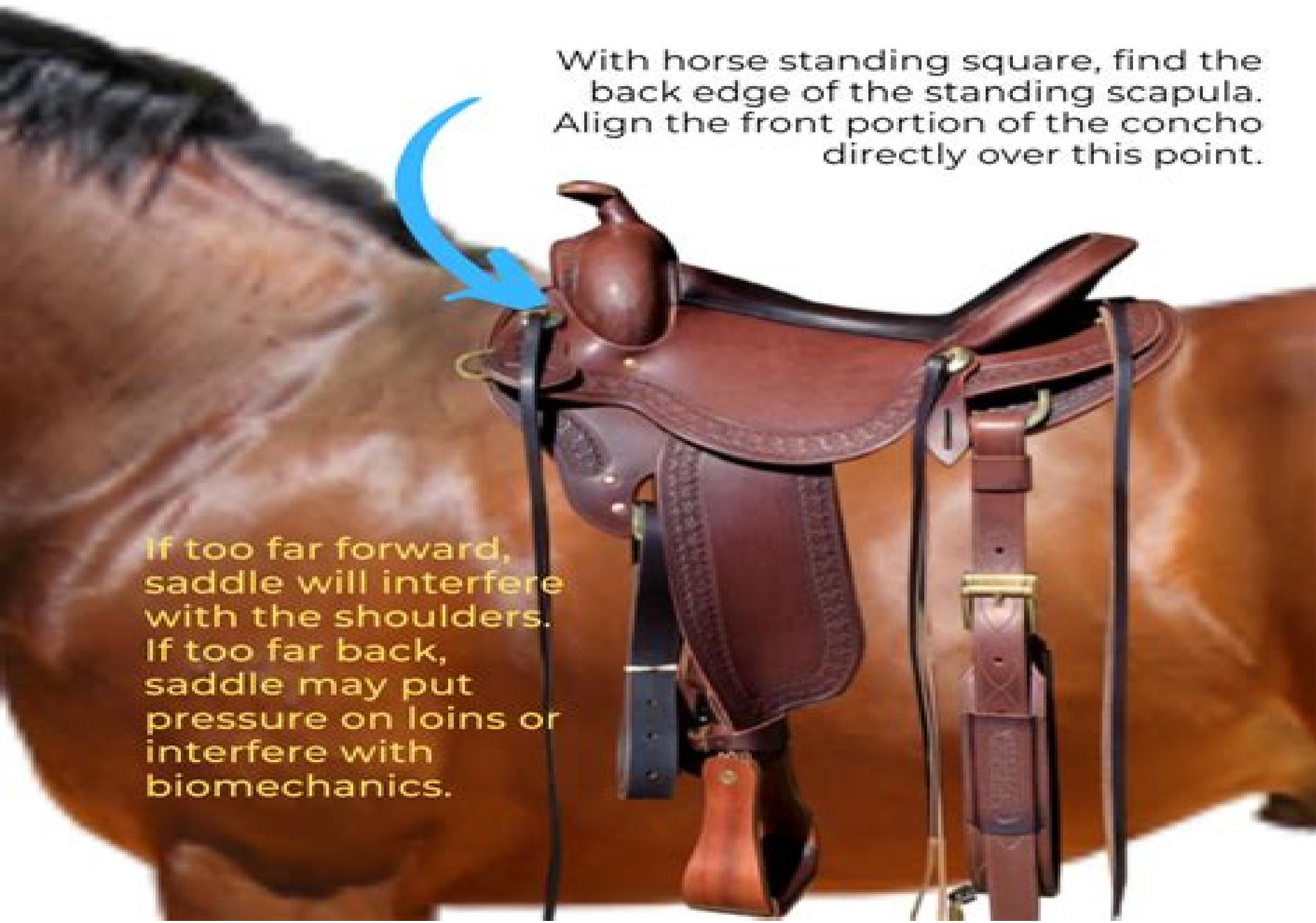


IDENTIFY PROPER SADDLE PLACEMENT

With horse standing square, find the back edge of the standing scapula. Align the front portion of the concho directly over this point.

If too far forward, saddle will interfere with the shoulders. If too far back, saddle may put pressure on loins or interfere with biomechanics.
